COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE

- Mr. Haire provided an update on the progress of the comprehensive plan. The steering committee has been meeting on third Thursday of every month. During the December meeting, the group reviewed the community survey results with consultant. This report, along with all meeting recordings, can be found on the Comprehensive Plan website – www.cwrowingtogether.com.
- Mr. Haire shared that there is still a lot of work to be done, not limited to finalizing a future land use map, an economic development plan, addressing transportation, and parks. The steering committee has requested an updated timeline of completion from the consultant and hope to have that soon.

OTHER LEGISLATION DISCUSSED/ADOPTED

- Council adopted 4 resolutions to accept easements associated with the development of three single family homes on Clinton Street and the installation of public utilities (RES-23-001 / 002 / 003 / 004).
- Council adopted a resolution for the Mayor's appointment of Eileen Goodin to serve the remainder of an unexpired term on the Planning & Zoning Commission (RES-23-005).
- Council adopted an ordinance to provide funding to the Canal Winchester Area Historical Society (ORD-22-058).
- Council adopted an ordinance to amend the contract with Columbus Pool Management (ORD-22-059).
- Council heard the first reading of an ordinance to appropriate funds from the General Fund, Water Fund, and Canal Pointe Industrial Public Water System Fund (ORD-23-001). Details on the appropriations can be found in the meeting packet.
- Council heard the first reading of an ordinance to accept a parcel of land from Canal Pointe, LCC, to add to Howe Pond Park (ORD-23-002).
- Council heard the first reading of an ordinance to accept a parcel of land along Clinton Street as part of the public right-of-way (ORD-23-003).
